We had FLN exhibition and Basha Utsav which encouraged and flourished the skill of display and presentation among students and also they could expose their academic talents to their maximum.

### **SPECIAL EDUCATION DEPARTMENT REPORT**

Resource room of Kulapati Munshi Bhavan's Vidya Mandir functions with 3 special educators catering to the needs of 54 students. We have 32 students from primary and 22 from secondary. Children needing constant support are provided with shadow teachers who help them to adjust and function in the classroom. Main focus is to develop the basic skills of reading, writing, spelling & math. If children attending remediation have any behavioral issues then they are referred to the counselor for further help.

The Counseling Cell aims at creating a safe space for students to share their issues and also help promote positive mental health. Under the Counseling cell, currently there are around 10-12 clients consistently attending sessions for resolving their issues. Around 4-5 cases were closed after visible changes were observed. Students also keep approaching and in case any major issues come up, necessary help and guidance is always provided. Further, workshops regarding various issues like bullying, emotional imbalance, anxiety, stress management, personal hygiene, anger management etc were conducted for creating awareness and fostering adaptive behavior.

### **NIOS**

Bhavan's Learning Centre is an addition of special education department wherein children who have difficulties in learning or who want to pursue their creative passion without compromising their studies are taught the subjects they had chosen through NIOS syllabus. This board helps students to study and appear for exams in a flexible manner. Last year we had 11 students who appeared for the Secondary Board Exam. Prarthna Sasikumar was the topper with 84 %. In senior secondary, there were 13 students who appeared for the board exam. In the Commerce stream Abhinav Madhav who scored 74% stood first, while Athira Sathish who scored 86% topped the Humanities stream. Adasrsh Ranjith who opted for NIOS to attend regular coaching classes for cricket has been selected in the under 19 Indian team. Congratulations to all.

This year we have 50 students in both secondary and senior secondary together. Along with academics the creativity and artistic talents of our students are enhanced. We conducted "Ruchi Bhavana", an art, craft and food festival where children exhibited their creativity. Through "Bhavana Sparsh", Annual day of Bhavan's Learning Centre, which was inaugurated by famous music composer Shri Ratheesh Vega in December, children projected the victory of India in space by depicting the journey of humans from worship in the moon to landing on it through Chandrayaan.
