Academics

AISSCE Results

In the AISSCE Science Stream, out of 137 students who appeared for the exam, 48 students scored 90 and above in all subjects. 99 students passed with distinction, and 38 students passed with first class. The first topper of the school, Kavya Rajan scored 98%, Ajith A stood second with 97.2% and Nanda Prasad stood third with 96.2%. In Physics, Ajaykrishnan K V scored centum. In Computer Science, two students- Sreehari Rajesh and Sneha R scored centum. In the Commerce Stream, 48 students appeared for the exam, out of which 11 students scored 90 and above. 42 students passed with distinction, 5 with first class and one with second class. The first topper in Commerce Stream, Priti Sanjay scored 95%, Rahul Ayinkalath stood second with 94.8% and Aswin Cheerath Anilkumar stood third with 93.8%.

Fifteen students scored A1 in all the subjects, eight students scored 90 and above in all subjects and thirty-six students scored aggregate marks above 90%. Subject-wise Analysis:

In the AISSE Class X results, out of 197 students who appeared, 118 students scored 90 and above, 50 students secured distinction, 17 passed with first class, 12 passed with second class. The school toppers are Deepak K R, Sreelakshmi K, Sarika S Therambil, Abel Viji George and Dhevinandhana O S with 99%. Sreehari C stood second with 98.8% and Artdhana Krishna K stood third with 98.4%. Two students secured centum in

Sanskrit, nine students scored centum in Mathematics, eight students secured centum in Science and 22 students scored centum in Social Science.

Thirty-five students secured A1 in all subjects, thirty-eight students scored above 90 in all subjects — and forty-six students secured aggregate marks above 90%.
