- **Report on the activities conducted/organised during the year 2022-23**

The activities of the year began on the reopening day with a talk by Dr T P Sethumadhavan, Professor at Trans disciplinary University of Health sciences and Technology, Bangalore and Director (R&D) of Skill FAVS on “Emerging trends in Career”, for the students of Class 12 and their parents. World Environment Day was celebrated on 6th June, 2022. Reading Month-2022 was observed with a book exhibition-cum-sale by DC Books. International Yoga Day and International Music Day was observed in the school on 21st June. On June 24th, the students of the senior classes attended a session by Shri Mohankumar from Viyyur Police Station in connection with International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking. July 1st being Chartered Accountants’ Day and Doctors day, a Career Counselling programme for the students of Commerce and Humanities was conducted by Shri CA Geo Job and Dr P Sajeevkumar, Consultant, Respiratory Medicine, District Hospital, Palakkad addressed the students of the senior classes. An interactive session on Personality Development was held on 8th July 2022 for Grade 11 and 12 students. Important days such as Guru Purnima, Ramayana month, Kargil Vijay Divas were observed in the school with various programmes. An exhibition on Indigenous medicinal plants was conducted by Class 11 students on the occasion of World Conservation Day on 28th July, 2022. The message of Har Ghar Tiranga was passed on to all the students. Independence Day was celebrated on 15th of August, 2022. Madhuram Malayalam programme was initiated in the school on 19th August, by Dr. V Vijay Kumar VSA. The Investiture Ceremony, Bhavana Dhakshata, and Annual Sports Meet 2022 were held in the month of August 2022. On the occasion of National Sports Day on 29th August, the students of the Primary Section participated in the Football Shoot Out conducted in the school. Bhavana Sanskriti, The Cultural Festival 2022-23 was held on 30th and 31st August 2022 in the school auditorium. Onam celebrations were held in the school on 2nd September 2022. ‘Students for Students’ programme is a new initiative of the school, where senior students act as mentors, resource persons, storytellers, guides and at times even as caretakers. Teachers and students were given awareness classes on the spread of use of drugs among school students and a session on Identification of Autistic children and Management of their Behaviour in class for teachers in the month of September 2022. A day long Felicitation ceremony was held on 7th October, 2022 to honour the achievers of 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 in the SSE & SSCE exams. Teachers Day was celebrated on 11th October, 2022 (5th October being World Teachers Day). A training session on Mushroom cultivation, an Orientation session ‘Jump High to Reach Higher’ , ‘Dreaming Big’, a session explaining the pathways to crack the civil service exam, were also conducted for the students. Shikshan Bharati conducted a comprehensive evaluation of the school on 21st October, 2022. Primary Sports day was held on 28th October, 2022. Unity Day was observed on 31st October, with the students of Class 6 and 7 participating in the Unity Run and by taking the pledge. Anti- Drug campaign- Stop drugs for a healthy future was organised on 1st November, 2022 by the Humanities students.

Kerala Piravi, Foundation Day, Children's Day were celebrated in its full fervor. Pusthakapura, a programme to encourage home libraries, a workshop about liquid embroidery and some craft works were held for the students in November 2022. The Annual day of Bhavan's Learning Centre, 'Bhavana Sparsh' was held on 27th November 2022 wherein the students with special needs displayed their talents in various forms, which held the audience spellbound. Field trips were conducted by the Art Club and Malayalam department and class excursions were also conducted. Constitution day was celebrated on 30th November 2022 by the Humanities department. World Computer literacy day was observed on 2nd December 2022. The Primary and KG Christmas celebrations were held on 22nd December, 2022 with kids decked up as angels and Santa Claus. National Mathematics day was observed on 22nd December 2022. Training session on ECCE- Early Childhood Care and Education was held on 2nd January 2023 for KG and primary teachers. Bhavana Dyuti 2023, Primary Annual Day- 'Budha Mayoore' was conducted on Sunday, 22nd January, 2023. Republic day was celebrated on 26th January 2023, with a great display of talent by the students. The KMBVM Quiz Club conducted quizzes on every important occasion in the school. Assembly programmes on various themes and special days are conducted throughout the year. The tiny tots of the KG section are always active and creative with their display of activities on their celebrations of different colour days. Our teachers are continuously empowering and enriching our students, but they never failed to upgrade and update themselves by doing various courses to become Guide Captains, Innovative Ambassadors, etc.

Charitable Initiatives

Charitable activities are an integral part of our school. 'A coin a week' is a fund raising activity that is done every Wednesday. This year we could donate 70 armed chairs to the *Asha Bhavan*, an old age home for women run by the state government. 70 tea cups were provided to a similar institution at Padukkad. A huge collection of dress and play materials were donated to the pediatric ward of Govt. Medical College, Thrissur. Every year Rs.25000/- is donated to the Pain & Palliative Society, Thrissur. On special occasions, students present entertainment programmes at the Pain & Palliative Society and other old age homes.

PTA & Management initiatives

We are fortunate to have Parent representatives of our PTA executive committee who are very supportive and positive. There were many occasions, when we experienced abundant support from the parent community. Independence Day 2022 and *Navrathri* celebration in October 2022 included parent performances also. The most touching act from the parent community was in the form of charity. Our sincere thanks to each and every parent who always supported and trusted us. The Management committee of Bhavans Thrissur Kendra is very keen in developing its schools as centres of excellence. Our academic council plans to develop Thrissur Kendra as a knowledge Hub by 2025 and gives emphasis on developing language skills and incorporating sustainable development goals with the curriculum. In July 2022, following the NEP 2020, pre KG sections were opened. Jagaran, a programme started in 2019, works all-round the year for the development of the schools through empowerment of staff and students.
