Teachers Development Programmes:

Resorcio and the CBSE Plus Project - Resorcio is an innovative EdTech brand committed to revolutionize the education sector by creating dynamic, inclusive and impactful solutions for learners, educators and parents. One such initiative is the CBSE Plus Project, a transformative year-long program designed to address the challenges faced by students.
